Dear Parents and Families.

I am proud to announce that we have appointed two teachers to Leadership Positions within our school to further support our staff and students. Mrs Grace Provino will be in charge of Early Stage One/Stage One as their Stage Leader to allow Mrs Frank to concentrate more deeply on her Instructional Leader role where she will collect, analyse and use data to improve the literacy outcomes for your children. This will be in K-2.

Mrs Provino will be overseeing Band and participating in it on Wednesday mornings. This will help the children see the value we as staff place on music. It is hoped the band will soon play regularly for school assemblies and events.

We are investing heavily in K—2 Literacy and Numeracy, as research evidences Early Intervention is the most effective. Mrs Naranjo is delivering intensive personalised reading instruction to a selection of students for half an hour each per day. Extra School Learning Support Officers are working throughout the school with all children. This will give Colo Vale children the best start possible.

On Monday night, I had the chance to meet with the P&C to discuss issues concerning our school.

I would like to thank the P&C for their unwavering support, encouragement and involvement in the life of Colo Vale School. I think we all agreed on Monday that open, clear communication is the cornerstone of a successful partnership between school and the community it

Our school has recently had a revamp of the school website. This training was undertaken by Mrs Wood, Miss Bannerman and Mrs Brunton, who have spent considerable time getting our website up to date.

Currently, Skoolbag is used to send out most of our communication. It is secure, private and personalised for our school. The app can be downloaded from iTunes or GooglePlay and will walk you through installation. You will receive an email each time a Skoolbag Notification goes up so it is easy to keep up to date.

Our second source of communication is Facebook which I am not keen to use as often, simply due to the access of the public. I accept many parents use it but encourage you to download the Skoolbag app and begin using it. We will still post some information of Facebook.

Our third source of communication is the school website. This has all the information you should need and is regularly updated by Miss Bannerman, Mrs Brunton and Mrs Wood. This is our face to the outside world.

After this, we have paper. I have noticed how much paper is expended in our school and am keen to reduce it.

I will be surveying the parent community shortly regarding communication methods with the school, as we seek to find user friendly, equitable, accessible methods to communicate together.

Finally, with the winter weather well and truly upon us. I encourage you to keep your children warm, provide them with plenty of nutritious food and keep them home if they are unwell to avoid spreading bugs amongst other children. Full winter uniform time is here.




Submission:
